Stark SWCD 2012 Tree/Fish Sale Information

The Stark Soil and Water Conservation District is now accepting tree seedling and fish fingerling orders.

TREES: Stark SWCD is partnering with the Licking SWCD to offer this great variety of tree seedlings. Unfortunately, due to this partnering we will be unable to coordinate the tree pick up date with the fish pick up date as we have in the past. Trees will be picked up in the SWCD office (suite 103 in the USDA Service Center on Richville Drive). **Pickup date for trees is Friday, April 13th.** The office is open from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. Please call the office for other arrangements. Only pre-paid orders will be available; No trees will be sold at the door. Order form inside and at www.starkswcd.org.

NOTE: All trees and shrubs are state and federally inspected. We may need to make reasonable substitutions based on availability of certain species. All trees and shrubs are bare-root seedlings 5" - 18" in height.

FISH: The Fender's Fish truck will once again be parked alongside the curb on Business Place (near Anchor Baptist Church parking lot). Please provide your own containers, lined with a plastic bag and partially filled with your pond water to transport your fish home. Deadline for ordering fish is April 5th. **Fish pickup will be Tuesday, April 10th 9:30—11:00 am only.** Only fish pre-ordered will be available for pick up.
