

Green Cleaning Recipes:

Kitchen:

Cabinet Cleaner:

- 2 parts baking soda
- 1 part oil (vegetable, canola, olive)
- 1. Combine ingredients and stir
- 2. Apply to cabinets and wipe with a moist cloth

Coffee Maker Cleaner (automatic or Keurig):

Vinegar

White distilled vinegar can help to dissolve mineral deposits that collect in automatic drip coffee makers from hard water.

- 1. Fill the reservoir with white distilled vinegar
- 2. Run through a brewing cycle
- 3. Rinse thoroughly with water when the cycle is finished.

(Be sure to check the owner's manual for specific instructions.)

Dishwasher Soap:

- 8 ounces of Castile Soap
- 1 cup of water
- 2 teaspoons of lemon juice
- Combine ingredients in a bowl or squirt bottle
- 2. Stir or shake gently
- Place one tablespoon of the above mixture into the OPEN compartment of your dishwasher
- 4. Add a cup of white vinegar to the CLOSED compartment.

Microwave Cleaner:

- ½ cup vinegar
- 2 cups water
- Combine ingredients in a microwave safe how!
- 2. Heat on high for 3-4 minutes
- Remove bowl and wipe down inside of microwave

Garbage Disposal Cleaner:

- 1 cup vinegar
- 1 Tablespoons of dried rosemary (substitute 2-3 fresh sprigs if you don't have dried rosemary on hand)
- Lemon and orange peels (the more you use, the stronger the citrus scent will be.)
- Ice cube tray
- 1. Fill your ice cube tray about ¾ of the way to the top with white vinegar.
- Slice citrus peels (oranges, limes, grapefruit, or lemons – whatever was destined for the compost bin) into thin slices, then cut in half again to make small chunks.
- 3. Place the peel into the ice tray.
- 4. Sprinkle a small amount of rosemary into each cube as well.
- 5. Place your ice cube tray in the freezer and allow it to set for approximately 2 hours, or until frozen.
- Place 2 4 ice cubes in the garbage disposal and turn it on. The vinegar cuts through grime, the citrus helps to clean, and all three ingredients work to disinfect.

Stove top Cleaner:

- 1 Tablespoon Baking Soda
- 3 drops Citrus Essential Oil (orange, grapefruit, etc.)
- ½ Tablespoon Water
- 1. Combine baking soda and water until they create a paste
- 2. Add 3 drops of citrus essential oil and mix
- 3. Spread paste directly onto the cook top, and clean.



Bathroom:

Glass and Mirror Cleaner:

- 1 cup vinegar
- ½ cup distilled water
- 8 drops citrus essential oil (optional)
- 1. Combine ingredients in a spray bottle
- 2. Spray on glass and wipe with a cloth

Toilet Fizz Bombs:

- 1 cup baking soda
- 1/3 cup citric acid
- 30-40 drops of essential oil
- ½ teaspoon vinegar
- 1 tablespoon hydrogen peroxide
- Spray bottle
- 1. Mix the baking soda and citric acid in a bowl
- 2. Add the essential oils and mix with a fork (at this point the mixture will be very dry)
- 3. Take the spray bottle of water and start misting the mixture, while continuing to mix and fluff with the fork.
- 4. When the mixture starts to clump, pick up a small amount with your hand. If you can form a loose ball you're complete. If not, continue misting and mixing until you are able
 - Note: if you add too much water, your mixture will start to fizz. Stop immediately. You want the fizzing action to happen in the toilet bowl.
- 5. Take a spoonful of the mixture and stuff it into an ice cube tray
- 6. Let the toilet bombs dry overnight
- 7. Place in an airtight container for storage (ex. Mason jar)
- 8. On cleaning day: drop the toilet bomb into the bowl, and let it bubble and fizz until dissolved. Wait 20-30 minutes, and clean the bowl with a toilet brush, and flush.

Showerhead Cleaner:

- 1/3 cup baking soda
- 1 cup white vinegar
- 1 plastic bag
- 1 Twist tie
- 1. Pour baking soda into the bag
- 2. Place the bag over the shower head
- 3. Add the vinegar
- 4. Secure bag over shower head with the twist tie
- 5. Let sit several hours or overnight.

Household:

All-purpose cleaner:

- 3 cups distilled water
- 1 cup vinegar
- 5 drops lemon essential oil
- 15 drops tea tree essential oil
- 1. Combine ingredients in a spray bottle
- 2. Fill the remainder of the bottle with hot water

Air Freshener:

- ½ cup rubbing alcohol
- 1 cup water
- Essential oil (of your choice)
- Spray bottle
- 1. Combine ingredients in spray bottle
- 2. Spray throughout room or on upholstery

Drain Cleaner:

- 1 cup baking soda
- 1 cup white vinegar
- 1 gallon boiling water
- 1. Pour the baking soda down the drain
- 2. Pour the vinegar down the drain
- 3. Wait 5 minutes, or until the fizzing ceases
- 4. Pour the boiling water down the drain
- 5. Repeat as necessary

Furniture Polish:

- 2 cups distilled water
- 1 Tablespoon olive oil



- Lemon juice (squeeze 1 lemon)
- 1. Combine ingredients in a spray bottle
- 2. Test on wood before use

Wood Cleaner for water or alcohol marks:

- ½ cup distilled water
- ½ cup vinegar
- 1. Combine ingredients
- 2. Rub with the grain and polish for the best results.

Cleaning Wipes:

- 1 cup distilled water
- 1 cup vinegar
- 15 drops lavender essential oil
- 5 drops lemon essential oil
- 5 drops tea tree essential oil
- Large glass jar with lid (24 oz mason jar)
- 4 washcloths
- 1. Roll the washcloths and place in a jar
- 2. In a small bowl combine the water, vinegar, and essential oils.
- 3. Pour vinegar mixture over the washcloths, pressing the washcloths down into the liquid. The washcloths should be wet, and you may choose to add more water if needed.
- 4. Close the lid on the jar Remove the washcloths from the jar as needed. Launder used washcloths, and repeat the process.
- *Use water-based products quickly. This product does not contain a preservative and runs the risk of bacterial introduction.

Floor Cleaner:

- 2 cups warm water
- 1-2 drops castile soap
- 3-5 drops tea tree essential oil
- 1. Combine ingredients in a container and mix.

Toilet/Bathroom Cleaner:

1 cup water

- 1/8 cup castile soap
- 10 drops peppermint essential oil
- 10 drops melaleuca essential oil
- 1. Combine ingredients in a container and mix.

Granite Cleaner:

- ¼ cup rubbing alcohol
- 1 teaspoon castile soap or dawn dish soap
- 1 cup water
- 1. Combine ingredients in a sterile spray bottle and shake.

Natural Lysol:

- 2 cups water
- 10 drops lemon essential oil
- 5 drops lavender essential oil
- 15 drops rosemary essential oil
- 15 drops melaleuca essential oil
- 1. Add ingredients into a plastic bottle
- 2. Cap the bottle and shake.

Laundry:

Fabric Softener:

- 1 cup distilled water
- 4 cups vinegar
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 20 drops essential oil (tea tree)
- 1. Combine water and baking soda
- 2. Slowly pour in vinegar
- 3. Add 10 drops of essential oil
- 4. Stir slowly

Bleach Alternative:

- 12 cups water
- 1/4 cup lemon juice
- 1 cup hydrogen peroxide
- 1. Mix ingredients together and place in a dark container.
- 2. Add 2 cups per wash load or put in spray bottle and use as a household cleaner.



Stain Remover:

- 1 Tablespoon baking soda
- 4 Tablespoon dish or castile soap
- 8 Tablespoons hydrogen peroxide
- 1. Combine all ingredients in a small jar and stir to combine well.
- Apply directly to the stain and rub gently with your finger, a piece of fabric or an old toothbrush. Allow stain remover to sit for at least 15 minutes, or up to an hour. Wash normally.

Personal Care:

Hand soap:

- ¾ cup water
- 5 drops tea tree
- ¼ cup castile soap
- 5 drops peppermint oil
- Combine ingredients and pour into container

Make-up Bruch Cleaner:

- 8 oz vinegar
- 1.6 oz rubbing alcohol
- ½ Tablespoon dish soap
- ½ Tablespoon mild shampoo or baby shampoo
- 1 Tablespoon conditioner
- 2. Combine all ingredients in a mason jar or other container
- 3. Stir well
- 4. Wet brush bristles. Rub them to lather the soap and rinse until water runs clean. You may have to repeat if brushes are very dirty.
- 5. Lay brushes flat on a towel to dry

Hand Sanitizer Spray:

- 2 ounces witch hazel
- 1 teaspoon vitamin e oil

- 5 drops tea tree essential oil
- 2 drops lemon essential oil
- 1. Combine ingredients into a small squirt bottle and shake.
- 2. The witch hazel is a natural astringent and the vitamin E will moisturize

Hand Sanitizer Gel:

- 1 1/2 ounces pure aloe vera
- 3 teaspoons rubbing alcohol
- 1 teaspoon vitamin E oil
- 5 drops essential oil
- Combine ingredients into a small container with a lid. Shake liberally to mix all ingredients thoroughly.

If you want your gel to be slightly thinner in consistency, add a little more rubbing alcohol, up to one teaspoon.

Will keep for up to 2 months – may need a little shake before using.

Outdoor:

Mosquitto Repellent:

- 4 mason jars
- 40 drops essential oils (cedarwood, lavender, lemon, thieves)
- 2 fresh lemons
- 2 fresh limes
- 8 sprigs of fresh rosemary
- Floating tea light candle
- Distilled Water
- 1. Fill the mason jar half-way with water
- 2. Add the lemons, limes, rosemary, and essential oils
- 3. Stir
- 4. Fill the rest of the jar with water
- 5. Float the tea light on the water
- 6. Light the candle
