



2023 Conservation Poster Contest

Why Participate?

- * Project Based Learning through poster design and researching the theme can give your students a voice in your community on important conservation issues.

Rules

- * **Who Can Participate?** The 2023 Poster Contest is open to all students in grades K-12. Students in public, private or home school.
- * Any media can be used on a 14"x22" (half a poster). Only digital submissions (photograph or scanned copy of the handmade posters in a JPEG format) will be accepted. Photographs must be clear and well-framed.
- * All posters must be created by an individual student, rather than a team of students.
- * The 2023 theme "One Water" must be included on the front side of each poster.
- * A signed and legible entry form must be submitted with each poster to be eligible for judging (see next page).
- * Teachers - If you have a class, please limit submissions to the Top 5 best posters.

Stark SWCD Rules

- * Posters are due to Stark SWCD by May 25, 2023. Visit www.starkswcd.org for more information and poster resources.
- * Email digital posters to ajbock@starkcountyohio.gov
- * Each submission must include a completed and signed entry form for consideration

Poster Evaluations

The posters are evaluated on the following criteria:

- * Conservation message (50 percent) (Poster uses correct theme - "One Water")
- * Visual effectiveness (30 percent)
- * Originality (10 percent)
- * Universal appeal (10 percent)

Prizes

- * Stark Soil and Water Conservation District Prize: Prizes awarded for 1st place in each age group
K-1; 2-3; 4-6; 7-9; 10-12
- * The winners from each age group will move on to the state level and state winners will be eligible for NACD National Poster Contest and prizes.
